



Eligibility:

To be eligible for a Kids' Chance of Oklahoma, Inc. scholarship, applicants must have a parent who has been seriously or fatally injured in a workplace accident in Oklahoma. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and meet the following requirements:

- Must be between the ages of 17 and 25 at the time of disbursement of the scholarship award.
- May be married or single.
- Reside in the state of Oklahoma.
- Have a high school diploma, GED, or be a high school senior. Academic achievement, student government involvement, aptitude, extracurricular activities, and community service of the applicant are considered.
- Maintain a GPA of 2.5.
- Must be enrolled as a full- or part-time student at an accredited institution in the United States: a university or college to obtain a bachelor's or master's degree; a junior/community college to obtain an associate's degree; or a career tech school to obtain certification or license.

Timeline:

So that we can help as many students as possible, we are still awarding scholarships for the Spring 2017 semester. If you know of any students that may be eligible, please tell them about our scholarship opportunity and to visit our website at www.kidschanceok.org to apply. We are also accepting applications for the 2017-2018 academic school year.

Scholarship Amount:

The amount of each Kids' Chance of Oklahoma scholarship award is decided by the Scholarship Committee and Board of Directors. The award will be paid directly to the education institution. The award is contingent upon available funds.

Planning for College:

Planning for College can start at any age. Financial hardship often results from the death or serious injury of a parent due to a workplace accident, making it difficult for children to pursue their educational dreams.
